



Q2a: How much of a problem do you think each of the following is among youth (6th - 12th grade) in Hastings?













Q6: If you currently have prescription medication at your home, how is it stored? (select one)














Q12: Under what circumstances would you allow your teen to drink alcohol (more then a sip or taste)? (please check all that apply)




Would you allow your teen to use marijuana?






Would you allow teens to drink in your home if no one drove home?

Middle School (6th-8th)






Would you allow your teen to attend a party where drugs/alcohol were known to be present?








